### **TRAVEL INFORMATION FOR DELEGATES**

#### **Rail:**

Bristol Temple Meads is the closest train station.

#### **Bus:**

Bus Services 1/2 run from outside The Sidings pub (opposite Bristol Temple Meads main exit road), and from the city centre.

3/4 - Services run from the city centre.

8/72 – Services run from Bristol Temple Meads station and the city centre.

For all the above bus services ask for Triangle West.

#### **Taxi;**

There is a Bristol City Council taxi rank outside the station, (turn left on exit). Uber and other app-based services operate in Bristol.

#### **By Car:**

There is no parking available at the Humanities Complex. Street parking is a mix of local residents' (9am–7pm Mon-Sat on a permit basis) and pay and display bays which allow parking up to 3 hours. There is a long stay NCP car park nearby on Jacobs Wells Road, BS8 1EH.
