So, what are platelets?

- They play a key role in the process of blood clotting.
- They support the health of our blood vessels.
- Yet, they also contribute to a range of platelet diseases and disorders:





- Thrombosis is one of the major causes of heart attacks and strokes.
- Caused by formation of a blood clot.
- This clot could block an important blood vessel.
- Treatments include antiplatelet drugs, but these can lead to nuisance bleeding.
- ★ Bleeding occurs when our platelets do not work well
- Mor if we have too few platelets in our blood.
- ▶ Platelet disorders are the most common cause of bleeding disorders - with 6000 patients in the UK.




