



## RideLondon 2022 *factsheet*

After a two-year absence due to the pandemic, the world's greatest festival of cycling returns in 2022 – and we're delighted to have you on board for the 100-mile event on Sunday 29 May.

### Background

RideLondon was established by the Mayor of London in 2013 as an Olympic legacy event from the London 2012 Games. In addition to the 100-mile challenge, the 2022 RideLondon will also feature shorter, family-oriented rides on traffic-free roads. Further details of these events will be announced over the coming months.

### The world's greatest *festival of cycling*

The new-look RideLondon-Essex 100 is one of several changes to RideLondon, which include a new partnership with Essex County Council and a three-day UCI Women's WorldTour race (27 May to 29 May 2022).

The RideLondon FreeCycle will also return in 2022 with traffic-free, family-friendly routes and festival sites set to be announced next year.

### The *RideLondon-Essex 100* route

London's iconic Tower Bridge will be the stunning new Finish Line for the 2022 RideLondon-Essex 100.

It will be the first time since RideLondon was created in 2013 that the 100-mile challenge will finish at the capital's famous landmark.

The Start Line will be on Victoria Embankment and the route will then head out into Essex countryside for a 65-mile loop before returning to London and the finish at Tower Bridge. The full route will be announced in the new year.
